

RSAC Weekend Terms & Conditions

Article 1 – Estimated weekend cost for participants

1.1 The estimated cost of the weekend based on two days is communicated before the weekend.

1.2 The final price will be communicated after the weekend.

1.3 If the expected cost increases significantly (see Article 4), participants will receive an updated estimate and the option to opt out.

Article 2 – Cancellation policy

2.1 Participants may cancel free of charge up to two days after the sign-up deadline, specifically communicated about that weekend.

2.2 After this period, cancellation is still possible under the following condition:

- The participant will be charged for any costs already incurred.

2.3 Within 7 days before the weekend, cancellation is no longer possible.

- The participant will be charged for all costs related to the weekend.

2.4 Once a cancellation has been made, it is final and cannot be reversed.

Article 3 – Chargeable costs

3.1 The total cost of the weekend may include, but is not limited to:

- Groceries
 - Materials and equipment
 - Camping fees
 - Fuel (see document of fuel declaration)
 - Rental cars
 - Staff-related costs
 - Unexpected necessary costs (e.g. missing food or essential camping equipment)

Article 4 – Significant cost changes for the weekend

4.1 A cost increase is considered significant when costs increase above the highest previously communicated estimate.

4.2 In case of a significant increase:

- Participants will be informed as soon as possible.
- Participants will receive a 24 hours opt-out period.

4.3 If a participant opts out:

- The participant remains responsible for any non-refundable costs already incurred
 - The organization will make reasonable efforts to minimize these costs

Article 5 – Car rental policy

5.1 A rental car may be arranged if it benefits the weekend.

5.2 All reasonable options must be considered to keep costs low.

5.3 If costs remain within the previously estimated weekend cost no prior approval from participants is required.

5.4 A rental car must be filled to at least 75% capacity to justify rental, unless:

- It is required for a course, in which case a driver alone is sufficient.

5.5 The costs of the rental car are covered by all participants, except car providers.

5.6 When a car is rented, it is mandatory for the driver to make sure the car is insured.

Article 6 – Declaration of additional cost

6.1 Additional costs required to provide a car must:

- Be discussed in advance
- Be approved beforehand

6.2 These costs are only allowed if:

- Approved by the KlimCo
- The price has been agreed upon in advance

Article 7 – Cancellation in exceptional circumstances

7.1 In case of exceptional circumstances (e.g. serious injury or death of a close relative):

- The participant must inform the organization as soon as possible

7.2 KlimCo may decide to waive part or all of the costs.

7.3 This decision is made solely at the discretion of KlimCo.

Article 8 – Cancellation of individual by the organization

8.1 KlimCo may cancel participation in cases including, but not limited to:

- Insufficient cars available
- Rental costs exceeding the agreed budget

8.2 If participation is cancelled by KlimCo:

- The participant will not be charged for any costs already incurred

Article 9 – Participant cancellation priority order

9.1 If the number of participants must be reduced, the following priority order applies from least to most:

- Alumni
- Toprope members
- Sport climbing / multipitch members
- Committee members
- Board members
- KlimCo (organization)
- Course members

9.2 If selection is required within a subgroup:

- A random lottery will be used

Article 10 – Full weekend participation

- 10.1 Participation applies to the full weekend only. Partial attendance is not allowed.
 - 10.2 Participation is only possible as part of the organized group.
 - 10.3 Exceptions may be granted by KlimCo with explicit approval.
 - 10.4 Participation is only possible for RSAC members.

Article 11 – Weekend rules

- 11.1 RSAC statutes and house rules apply at all times.
 - 11.2 Participants must follow instructions from KlimCo and the weekend manager.
 - 11.3 Any disputes regarding rules or disagreements may be discussed with the board as an intermediary.

Article 12 – Liability

- 12.1 RSAC is not responsible for damage to personal vehicles.
 - 12.2 Damage to rental cars is the responsibility of the driver.
 - 12.3 Costs for rental car damage will not be shared with other participants.
 - 12.4 If a car provider cancels within 7 days before the weekend, and this results in cancellation of other participants, additional costs (e.g. camping fees) may be charged to the driver.

Article 13 – Fines and violations

- 13.1 Traffic fines and violations are the responsibility of the driver.
 - 13.2 These costs cannot be charged to RSAC or other participants.

Article 14 – Damage to property

- 14.1 Any damage caused by a participant must be paid by that participant.
 - 14.2 RSAC and other participants are not liable.

Article 15 – Alcohol and safety

15.1 Alcohol use directly before or during climbing is prohibited.

15.2 Drug or excessive alcohol use will result in a ban from climbing activities that weekend.

15.3 Unsafe behavior will be reported and may result in a ban from climbing activities that weekend.

Article 16 – Discounts applied to the price for participants of the weekend

16.1 Discounts applied for the price of the weekend are as follows:

- Active instructor: 100%
 - Instructor in training: 50%
 - Weekend manager: 50%
 - Providing a personal car: 25% (not applicable to rental cars)
